Gen 3: God judges us on the "Last Day" --> at
the Resurrection of the dead, shows the
effects of our sins and good deeds

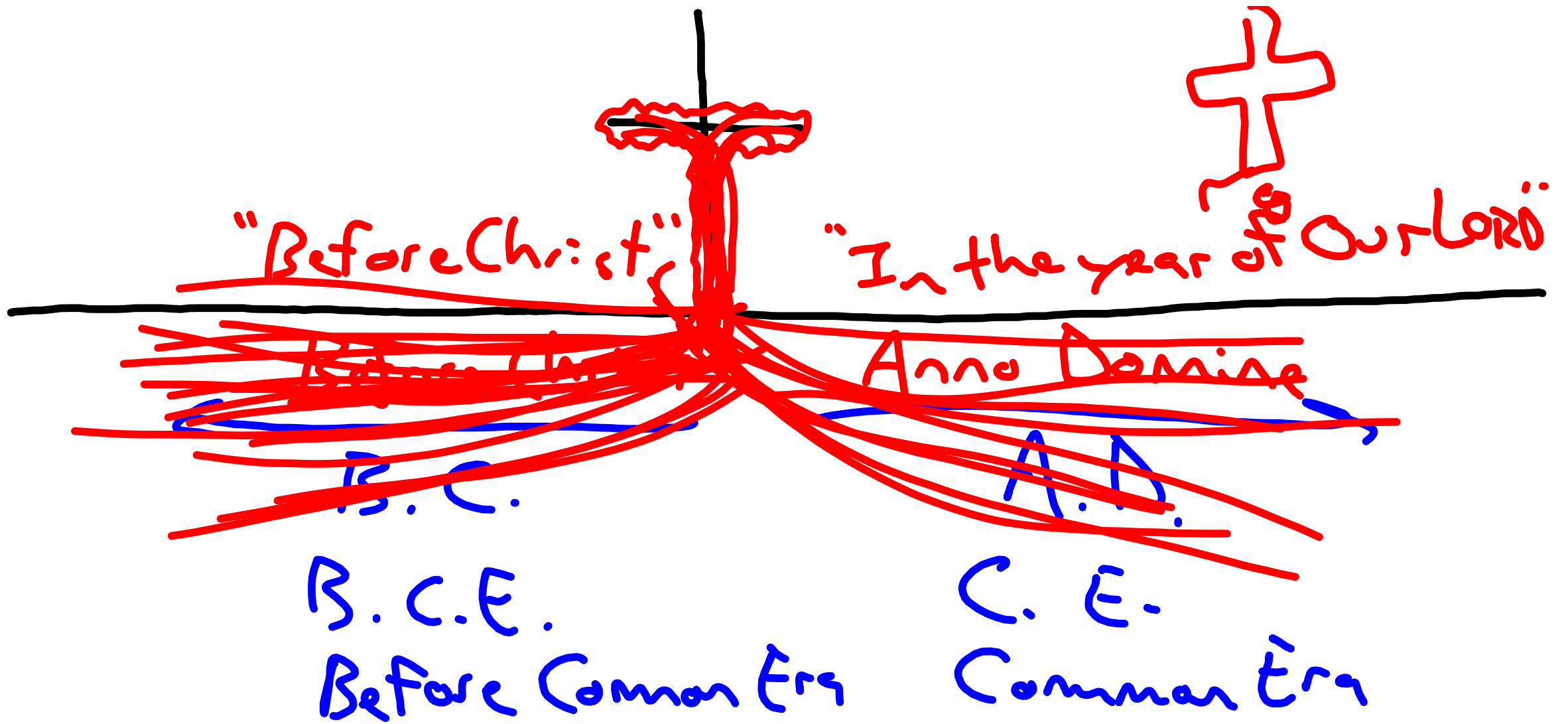
Heaven: a realm where we go after

death

to live eternally with God, His angels,
and the saints

Hell: a realm for those who refuse to
believe and be converted, where both
~~body and soul are lost~~ for eternity. The
absence of God is felt.

Purgatory: a realm where those who are
~~assured~~ of Heaven, but who still have
penance to do, are purged of their sin to
prepare them for Heaven.

The Three-Fold Church → People of God
COMMUNION of SAINTS

1) The Church Militant: Human beings on Earth. = US

2) The Church Expectant (Suffering): Human souls in Purgatory. Expecting Heaven.

3) The Church Triumphant: The saints and Angels in Heaven.

2 Maccabees 12:38-46

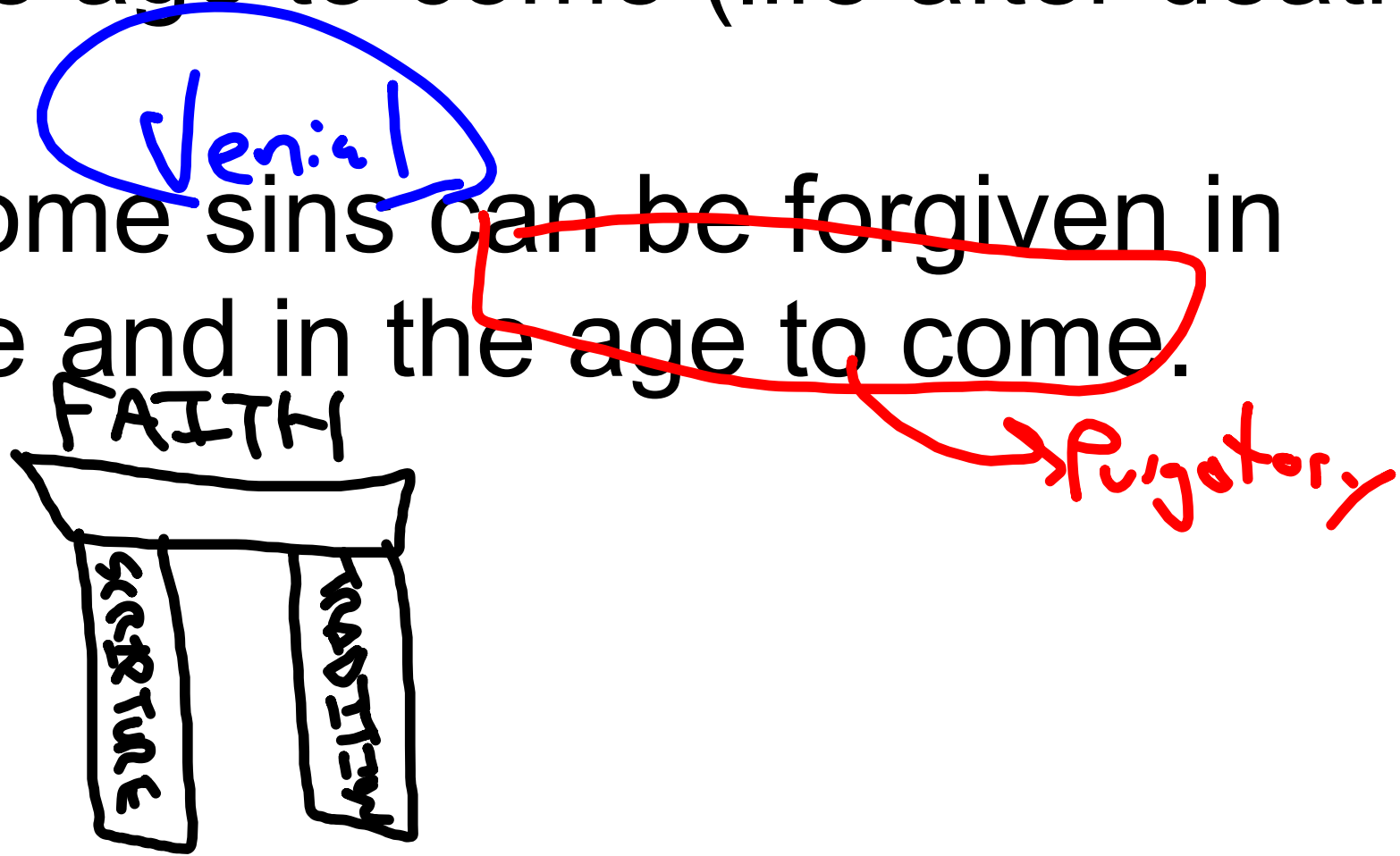
Context: Greek culture, language, and religion were being forced upon the Jews - even so far as to put a statue of Zeus in the Holy Temple. Maccabees is about a rebellion against the Greeks that was successful until the Romans came. → Holiday → Hannukah

- "They prayed that the sinful deed might be fully blotted out."
- they took a collection to pay for a sacrifice to be offered on behalf of the sins of their fallen comrades
- he acted in an excellent and noble way - thinking of the Resurrection of the Body
- "thus he made atonement for the dead that they might be freed from this sin" ✓

Matthew 12:32

- Sins against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven in this age (life on earth) or in the age to come (life after death)

- So, some sins can be forgiven in this age and in the age to come.

Foundation on Jesus:

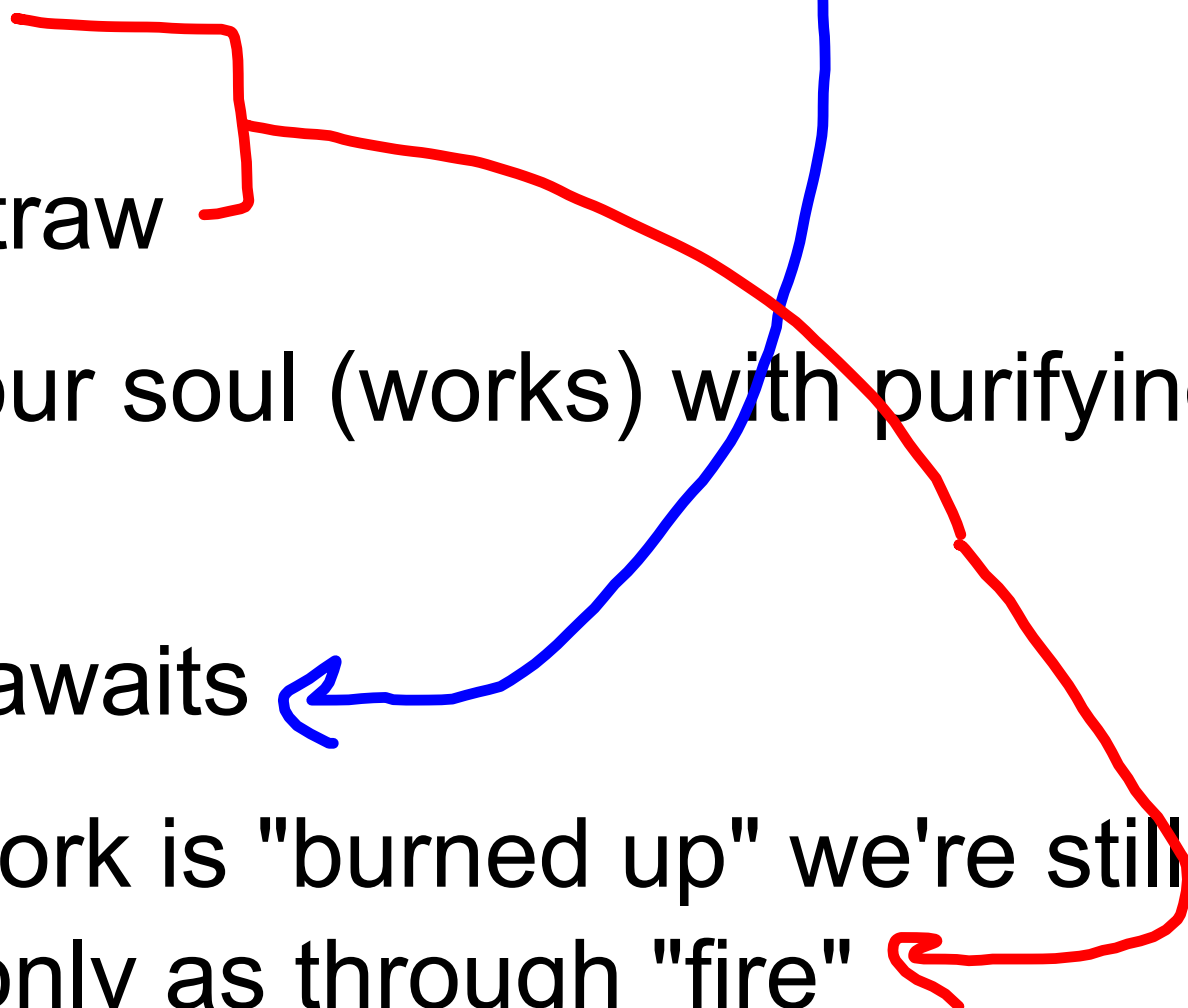
1. gold, silver, precious stones

Matthew 16:13-20

- Jesus gives Peter and the Church the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven

- "Keys" lock or unlock

- Trust and Responsibility

- Powers to bind + loose with rope

Bind: tie up (attach a penance)

Loose: loosen rope (lift the penance) - remit temporal punishment

Penance - makes you realize the damage you've caused; an attempt to make things right; (Satisfaction; Reparation)

"Temporal Punishment" - the consequences of sin inside of time

Indulgences CCC #1471

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as ministers of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

- What an indulgence is NOT.

Not permission to sin.

Not a pardon of future sins.

Not "buying" salvation for you or for others.

Medieval + Renaissance Period, Indulgences were being sold - this was an error, an abuse of Church teaching by individuals motivated by greed.

Martin Luther decided that rather than eliminating the abuse, he would attempt to eliminate the doctrines of Purgatory and indulgences, so he decided he would have to eliminate the Scriptural support for indulgences by removing Maccabees from the Bible.

↳ the Church has the authority to impose penances
and grant indulgences

↳ Ghosts do not haunt, but God may send the souls of
the dead to Earth for His purposes

↳ The dead cannot escape hell but God may
send a saint to Purgatory or Earth

2 Maccabees 15:12-16

↳ the saints in Heaven pray for the living on Earth

↳ the living on Earth can pray for others on Earth
