

Saint Joseph Middle School Conduct Plan

We will use our current middle school tier system. In addition to this system, we will institute a series of consequences and rewards for these tiers.

- Students will now be on an accumulating mark system.
- When a student earns a mark, or marks, they will end up on Tier 0 - Tier 3.
- Points will accumulate each week based on the following scale:
 - Tier 0 = -2 points (note: point total cannot go negative)
 - Tier 1 = -1 point
 - Tier 2 = 2 points
 - Tier 3 = 3 points
 - Additional points: For each additional 3 marks above the 5 for the Tier 3, an additional point will be added.
- **Morning Detention**

When a student earns a Tier 3 for the week - they will receive morning detention for three days the following week (M-F). In an effort to assist parents in scheduling, parents will choose 3 of the 5 days the following week to bring their child to morning detention. Detention will be a silent study hall in a middle school teacher's classroom from 7:10-7:40. If a student does not complete their full detention each week, it will be a mark for each day missed.

Consequences

Points Earned	Consequences
9	1 day OSS; Administrative Review Meeting (Admin, Priest, Counselor, Parents, Teachers, Coach Franklin)
12	2 days ISS
15	3 days ISS or 2 days OSS (Principal discretion)
18	Administrative Review of enrollment status

Note: If a student serves ISS or OSS, they are not eligible to lose points from their total for that week, regardless of their Tier. They are also not eligible for a Marvelous Monday ticket. Cumulative point totals will not go below zero.

The cumulative points will reset at the start of each semester.
